## NOTICE OF FINAL STATEMENT OF OBJECTIVES AND PROJECTED USE OF 1990-91 CITY OF MESQUITE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

The Community Development objective of the City of Mesquite is to assume decent, viable living areas and conditions for low and moderate income residents through projects and activities which stabilize and improve low and moderate income neighborhoods by the elimination of blighting influences and through the provision of public facilities and services.

Activities proposed to be undertaken with available funds are as follows: Available funds for Grant Year 1990-91 total \$553,322.

- Latchkey Care Program To continue providing after school care for low income latchkey children at Seabourn, Black, Shands and Hanby Elementary Schools.
- Special Kids Latch Key Program
   \$ 18,108
   To provide before and after school care for income eligible, multi-handicapped children, year-round at the Mesquite YWCA.
- Senior Citizen Center (Rutherford Park) \$250,000 Construction of a Senior Citizen Center at Rutherford Park.
- 4. Housing Rehabilitation Assistance \$200,000 To provide forgivable loans and emergency grants for low income homeowners to upgrade home to minimum housing standards.
- 5. CDBG Administration/Planning \$61,000
  To administer and monitor CDBG Program, assuring compliance with all related requirements, reporting and program regulations. To undertake review and update of current development and land use policies through supplementary studies. To assure adequate guidelines for development in order to protect and stabilize existing neighborhoods, while accommodating growth in an orderly manner.
- Fair Housing Administration \$ 2,000
   To administer and monitor the City's Fair Housing Ordinance, assuring compliance with all related requirements.

Total Projected Funding

\$553,322

The completion of the above listed projects will not cause any displacement of persons from their homes.
