RESOLUTION NO. 41-90

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, REQUESTING THAT THE TEXAS HIGHWAY AND PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION ACT FAVORABLY UPON A REQUEST REGARDING A PROPOSED EXTENSION OF STATE HIGHWAY 190 FROM STATE HIGHWAY 78 TO INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 20.

WHEREAS, a delegation from Dallas County is scheduled to appear before the Texas Highway and Public Transportation Commission on September 26, 1990 regarding a proposed extension of State Highway 190 from State Highway 78 to Interstate Highway 20, and

WHEREAS, the proposed extension of State Highway 190 through the City of Mesquite will provide greater mobility and significant economic benefits to the citizens of Mesquite, and


WHEREAS, studies have been conducted that establish the feasibility and need for such an extension of State Highway 190, and

WHEREAS, the Regional Planning Organization for the Dallas/Fort Worth area has, through its Regional Transportation Council, adopted a Dallas area mobility plan for 2010 that includes a circumferential outer loop generally consistent with the extension of SH 190 as recommended and illustrated in an engineering report prepared for Dallas County, Garland, Mesquite and Rowlett dated August, 1990;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite requests that the Texas Highway and Public Transportation Commission approve an extension of State Highway 190 from State Highway 78 to Interstate Highway 20 for project planning to include route studies, environmental reports, public meetings and hearings, schematics, and preparation of right-of-way maps and deeds.
