RESOLUTION NO. 44-90

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING AN OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER FOR THE CITY OF MESQUITE AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXTEND THE CURRENT CONTRACT FOR PUBLICATION OF THE CITY'S LEGAL ADVERTISEMENTS FOR A ONE-YEAR PERIOD; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the contract for publication of legal advertisements for the City of Mesquite will expire on September 30, 1990; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to extend the contract with the Dallas Times Herald for publication of legal advertisements beginning October 1, 1990, for a one-year period.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the <u>Dallas Times Herald</u>, a public newspaper of general circulation in the City of Mesquite, Texas, is hereby designated as the official paper of the City of Mesquite for the year beginning October 1, 1990, and ending September 30, 1991.

SECTION 2: That all ordinances, notices, and other matters required to be published under the laws of the State of Texas, the Charter of the City of Mesquite, or any ordinance thereof, shall be published in such official newspaper in the <u>East Community Section</u>, unless circumstances arise making it otherwise necessary to use the full run edition of the newspaper.

SECTION 3: That Mayor George A. Venner, Sr., is hereby authorized to extend the contract with the <u>Dallas Times Herald</u> for publication of the City's legal advertisements for a one-year period beginning October 1, 1990, and ending September 30, 1991.

SECTION 4: That such paper shall continue to act as the official newspaper of the City until another is designated by the City Council.

SECTION 5: That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon date of passage, as the law in
