## TOWN OF SUNNYVALE RESOLUTION NO. 90-17

A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AND THE TOWN OF SUNNYVALE, TEXAS, URGING THE COUNTY OF DALLAS, TEXAS TO ADD A ROADWAY TO BE KNOWN AS CLAY ROAD EXTENSION TO THE DALLAS COUNTY THOROUGHFARE SYSTEM AND INCLUDE THE PROJECT IN THE DALLAS COUNTY THOROUGHFARE IMPROVEMENT BOND PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite, Texas and the Town of Sunnyvale, Texas wish to petition the County of Dallas, Texas to add a certain project to the Dallas County thoroughfure system, namely a roadway to be known as the Clay Road Extension; and

WHEREAS, it is understood that a Dallas County Thoroughfare Bond Program is in its planning stage; and

WHEREAS, the cities herein named desire the Clay Road Extension project to be included in the program; and

WHEREAS, it is the best interest of both cities to cooperate fully in this endeavor for the benefit of the County as a whole;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCILS OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS AND THE TOWN OF SUNNYVALE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Dallas County is hereby urged to add the Clay Road Extension Project to its thoroughfare plan, to extend from existing Clay Road and S.H. 352 in Sunnyvale to East Glen Boulevard in Mesquite.

That the project be included in the next Dallas County Thoroughfare Improvement SECTION 2. Bond Program.

That in accordance with prior practices in County Bond Projects, the cities will provide SECTION 3. right-of-way for the roadway.


