

RESOLUTION NO. 51-90

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, TERMINATING ALL LEASE AGREEMENTS, OPERATING PERMITS, TEMPORARY PERMITS AND OTHER AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE CITY OF MESQUITE AND JIM HUDSON, ABC AIRLINES, AND/OR GERTRUDE HUDSON CONCERNING THE PHIL L. HUDSON MUNICIPAL AIRPORT AND TO EVICT SAID PERSONS FROM ALL PREMISES LOCATED AT THE AIRPORT.


WHEREAS, that the City Council of the City of Mesquite has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to terminate all lease agreements, operating permits, temporary permits and other agreements between the City of Mesquite and Jim Hudson, ABC Airlines, Gertrude Hudson and/or concerning the Phil L. Hudson Municipal Airport, and to take such action as necessary to evict said persons from all premises located at the airport.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite and its employees, agents, and attorneys, including but not limited to the law firm of Godwin, Carlton & Maxwell, P.C., is directed and authorized to terminate any lease agreements, operating agreements or other agreements between the City of Mesquite and Jim Hudson, Jim Hudson d/b/a ABC Airlines, and/or Gertrude Hudson concerning the Phil L. Hudson Municipal Airport and to commence, continue and maintain any lawsuit in any court of competent jurisdiction to terminate said lease agreements and to bring forcible entry and detainer actions or other similar actions in the Justice of the Peace Court, County Court or any other tribunal or administrative body to effect the foregoing action.

SECTION 2. That this resolution ratifies any prior action taken by the City of Mesquite, the City Attorney's Office and any of its employees, agents, and attorneys, including but not limited to the law firm of Godwin, Carlton & Maxwell, in connection with the institution of legal action against Jim Hudson, ABC Airlines and/or Gertrude Hudson.
