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RESOLUTION NO. 02-91

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS ENCOURAGING THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF DALLAS COUNTY TO INCLUDE FUNDS IN THE 1991 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BOND PROGRAM FOR THE PURPOSE OF STUDYING THE FEASIBILITY OF DEVELOPING A HIGHWAY EXTENDING FROM WHERE SH 190 INTERCHANGES WITH IH 20 TO SH 360 AND ACROSS AND NEAR THE CITIES OF MESQUITE, SEAGOVILLE, WILMER, LANCASTER, GLENN HEIGHTS, OVILLA, DESOTO AND CEDAR HILL.

WHEREAS, an outer loop in Dallas County known as Loop 9 has been included in Dallas regional planning documents for over twenty years;

WHEREAS, SH 190 and SH 161 are remnants of Loop 9 that have been included in the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation's Project Development Plan;

WHEREAS, future development in southern Dallas and northern Ellis Counties will require additional highway capacity, connecting the area to the balance of the region; and

WHEREAS, the preservation of a corridor for a future highway will not be possible unless feasibility is established, a route selected, and inclusion in the State's Project Development Plan be accomplished;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite urges the Dallas County Commissioner's Court to include funds for a feasibility study of a highway from the IH 20/SH 190 interchange south and west to SH 360 in the 1991 Capital Improvement Bond Program.


