RESOLUTION NO. 05-91

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, IN SUPPORT OF THE 1990-91 LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE OF THE GREATER DALLAS CRIME COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, The Greater Dallas Crime Commission and the undersigned local officials believe that the first function of government at all levels is to protect and safeguard the lives and property of its citizens;

WHEREAS, the citizens of the State of Texas, elected officials, judicial and civic leadership, consider the alarming crime rate and violence in our cities and counties to be wholly unacceptable to the point that the citizens we represent are becoming fearful and frustrated and are demanding immediate changes in the ever-increasing dysfunctional justice system;

WHEREAS, we unanimously feel that in spite of the dedication and best efforts of the criminal justice community and the Texas Legislature, the rate of crime and related drug activity has increased; and

WHEREAS, the pain and economic loss inflicted on our citizens resulting from crime require priority attention from private citizens and all levels of government officials alike;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, representing local government do hereby request that the current 72nd session of the Texas Legislature pass the proposed 1990-91 Legislative Package as proposed by the Greater Dallas Crime Commission hereby attached to this resolution.
