RESOLUTION NO. 07-91

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO GRANT PAID MILITARY LEAVE IN AN AMOUNT NECESSARY TO ENSURE NO LOSS IN WAGES BETWEEN MILITARY PAY AND NORMAL CITY SALARY TO ALL EMPLOYEES WHO WERE CALLED TO ACTIVE DUTY TO SERVE OUR COUNTRY IN OPERATIONS DESERT STORM AND DESERT SHIELD.

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to express its appreciation for the service and dedication of employees called to serve our country in Operations Desert Storm and Desert Shield; and


WHEREAS, the City Council deems it appropriate and in the best interest of the City to grant paid military leave in an amount necessary to ensure no loss in wages between military pay and normal city salary for a period of up to six (6) months from the date city wages ceased to all employees who were called to duty in Operations Desert Storm and Desert Shield.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to grant paid military leave in an amount necessary to ensure no loss in wages between military pay and normal city salary for a period of up to six (6) months from the date city wages ceased to all employees who were called to active duty to serve our country in Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage as the law in such cases provides.
