

RESOLUTION NO. 12-91

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF A RUNOFF ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS ON MAY 18, 1991, FOR THE ELECTION OF A CITY COUNCILMEMBER FOR PLACE 1; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, a Runoff Election was held on May 18, 1991, for the purpose of electing a Councilmember for Place 1 for a two (2) year term; and

WHEREAS, immediately after said election the Presiding Judges and other officers holding said election made their returns of the results thereof to the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That after examining said returns of said election and canvassing the votes in said election, the results of the election held May 18, 1991, are declared to be as follows:

It appearing that John Heiman received a majority of votes cast for the Office of Councilmember, Place 1, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve, after qualifying, for a term of two (2) years, commencing May, 1991, and until a successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage, as the Charter in such cases provides.
