

RESOLUTION NO. 23-91

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF A SPECIAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS ON AUGUST 10, 1991, FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING WHETHER TO ADOPT AN ADDITIONAL SALES AND USE TAX OF ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT TO BE USED TO REDUCE THE PROPERTY TAX RATE; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a Special Election was held on August 10, 1991, for the purpose of determining whether to adopt an additional sales and use tax of one-half of one percent to be used to reduce the property tax rate; and

WHEREAS, immediately after said election the Presiding Judges and other officers holding said election made their returns of the results thereof to the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That after examining said returns of said election and canvassing the votes in said election, the results of the election held August 10, 1991, are declared to be as follows:

Proposition No. 1: Adoption of an additional sales and use tax of one-half of one percent to be used to reduce the property tax rate.

Against	<u>1,013</u>

It appearing a majority of the votes were cast for the issue of adopting an additional one-half of one percent sales and use tax to be used to reduce the property tax rate, the proposition is hereby determined to have passed.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage as the Charter in such cases provides.
