

RESOLUTION NO. 29-91

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ENDORSING THE DESIGNATION OF STATE HIGHWAY 190 AS THE GEORGE BUSH FREEWAY IN HONOR OF THE 41ST PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES; ENCOURAGING ALL LOCAL GOVERNMENTS ALONG THE ROUTE OF STATE HIGHWAY 190, STATE HIGHWAY 161, AND SOUTH LOOP 9 TO CONSIDER DESIGNATING THE OUTER LOOP FRONTAGE ROADS AS THE GEORGE BUSH FREEWAY AS FUTURE SEGMENTS ARE CONSTRUCTED; AND OFFERING CONSULTATION AND ASSISTANCE TO APPROPRIATE LOCAL, STATE AND FEDERAL OFFICIALS IN PLANNING FOR A CEREMONY TO OFFICIALLY DEDICATE THE GEORGE BUSH FREEWAY.

WHEREAS, the frontage roads of SH 190 are either in place or under construction between SH 78 in Garland and US 75 in Plano and Richardson, and

WHEREAS, under the laws and policies of the State of Texas, highway names may be erected by cities as street name signs at intersections of freeway frontage roads according to standard maintenance agreements, and

WHEREAS, frontage roads are built or planned to be built in the Cities of Garland, Plano, Richardson, and Carrollton, and

WHEREAS, segments of SH 161 are being developed with frontage roads in the City of Irving and are planned with frontage roads in the City of Grand Prairie, and

WHEREAS, SH 190, SH 161, and South Loop 9 form an outer loop encircling the Dallas Metropolitan Area, and

WHEREAS, the County of Dallas and the Cities of Garland, Plano and Richardson have designated SH 190 as the George Bush Freeway, and

WHEREAS, George Bush, the 41st President of the United States, has resided in Texas for most of his life and has embraced the State of Texas as home for his family, and

WHEREAS, President bush has honored the State of Texas in a distinguished career of public service to his State, the United States and as a great world leader, and

WHEREAS, Interstate Highway 635, the inner freeway loop in Dallas County, is named after Texan Lyndon B. Johnson, the 36th President of the United States, and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that these great public works facilities - Interstate Highway 635 and State Highway 190 - honor two Texans who have served in the nation's highest office,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite endorses the designation of State Highway 190 as the George Bush Freeway in honor of the 41st President of the United States and encourages all local governments along the route of State Highway 190, State Highway 161, and South Loop 9 to consider designating the outer loop frontage roads as the George Bush Freeway as future segments are constructed.

SECTION 2. That the City of Mesquite will consult with and assist appropriate local, state and federal officials in planning a ceremony to officially dedicate the George Bush Freeway.


SECTION 3. That copies of this Resolution be forwarded to appropriate agencies of government.


