## RESOLUTION NO. 01-92

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MESOUITE, TEXAS, REQUESTING AND URGING DALLAS COUNTY TO PLACE HIGH PRIORITY ON THE RECONSTRUCTION OF HICKORY TREE ROAD; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the reconstruction of Hickory Tree Road from Military Parkway to Bruton Road was proposed by the City of Mesquite as its top priority in the Dallas County Bond Program; and

WHEREAS, the Dallas County Bond Program, including funding in the amount of \$2,352,000 for the Hickory Tree Road project, was approved by voters on November 5, 1991; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite has committed to participate with Dallas County in the cost of the Hickory Tree Road project to the full extent that the project cost may exceed Dallas County funds available for its construction; and

WHEREAS, the development of a convention center is considered to be of the highest community priority, serving the needs of the community and promoting the economic vitality of the community; and

WHEREAS, the opportunity has now been presented to pursue development of a convention center through cooperation of public and private interest on property controlled by the Mesquite Arena; and

WHEREAS, the timely reconstruction of Hickory Tree Road is of the utmost importance to the improvement of traffic access and circulation so essential to the operation of the proposed convention center and expanded operation of Mesquite Arena;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, does hereby request and urge the County Judge and Commissioner's Court of Dallas County place high priority on the reconstruction of Hickory Tree Road and proceed to schedule the project among those projects to be undertaken early in the 1991 Bond Program.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon date of passage as the law in such cases provides.
