RESOLUTION NO. 15-92

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS ON MAY 2, 1992, FOR THE ELECTION OF CITY COUNCILMEMBERS FOR PLACES 3, 4, AND 5; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a City Election was held on May 2, 1992, for the purpose of electing Councilmembers for each of the following places: Nos. 3, 4, and 5; for two (2) year terms; and

WHEREAS, immediately after said election the Presiding Judges and other officers holding said election made their returns of the results thereof to the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:




