RESOLUTION NO. 14-93

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PROGRAM'S PART TWO PERMIT APPLICATION, AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, EPA National Pollutant Elimination Discharge (NPDES) for storm water discharges is part two of a mandatory program for Municipalities whose population exceeds 100,000, being an extension of the 1992 amendments to the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (The Clean Water Act); and

WHEREAS, the City previously submitted their application for part one of the program, such application having been submitted in time for the due date of August 1, 1992 and approved by the Region 6 office of the EPA; and


WHEREAS, the permit application for part two is due August 1, 1993; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That they have been briefed on the NPDES Program and that James A. Prugel, Jr., City Manager, is hereby authorized to act on behalf of the City of Mesquite and submit the application for permit in connection with part two of EPA National Pollutant Elimination Discharge (NPDES) for storm water discharges.


SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage as the Charter in such cases provides.
