A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, SUPPORTING CITY PARTICIPATION IN THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S STATEWIDE TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM FOR 1994.

WHEREAS, the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991 (ISTEA) establishes a new vision for transportation in America, and

WHEREAS, it is a vision of a transportation system that contributes to the livelihood of our community and the quality and aesthetics of our environment, and

WHEREAS, both the motoring public and the citizens of Mesquite will benefit from participation by the City of Mesquite in the Statewide Transportation Enhancement Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council hereby supports City participation in the Statewide Transportation Enhancement Program through the sponsorship of the proposed projects described in Exhibits 1 and 2.

SECTION 2. That the City Council will provide for a twenty percent local participation funding match for the proposed projects described in Exhibit 1.

SECTION 3. That the City Council will provide for a fifty percent local participation funding match for the proposed projects described in Exhibit 2.
