

RESOLUTION NO. 04-94

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO HIRE UP TO FIVE (5) ADDITIONAL FIRE FIGHTERS OVER THE APPROVED BUDGET AMOUNT TO ALLEVIATE UNDERSTAFFING CAUSED BY EMPLOYMENT TERMINATIONS, AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City Council establishes the authorized strength of the Fire Department with the Annual Budget Resolution; and

WHEREAS, from time to time the authorized strength is reduced due to employment terminations; and

WHEREAS, a prospective Fire Fighter is involved in at least fourteen (14) weeks of training prior to being assigned to regular duty, and

WHEREAS, it is prudent to anticipate a time lag and provide a mechanism whereby full authorized strength may be maintained in all assigned positions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to hire up to five (5) additional Fire Fighters over approved strength to alleviate understaffing caused by employment terminations and the ensuing time required to train a Fire Fighter for regular duty.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage as the law in such cases provides.
