A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, RECOGNIZING SERVICE CENTER EMPLOYEES FOR THEIR EFFORTS TO RESTORE A 1924 REO FIRE TRUCK DONATED BY GEORGE LUCAS; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.
