## RESOLUTION NO. 14-94

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT GRANT APPLICATIONS AND EXECUTE AGREEMENTS IMPLEMENTING THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TRAFFIC LIGHT SYNCHRONIZATION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite recognizes that it is in the interest of the national economy to promote the conservation of energy resources and to reduce our nation's dependence on costly foreign oil; and,

WHEREAS, the retiming of signals by the City of Mesquite will provide benefits to the local community in the form of improved traffic flow, reduced fuel consumption, reduced vehicle operating costs, reduced air pollutant emissions, and improved safety due to smoother traffic flow; and,

WHEREAS, funds have been established and are available through the Texas Department of Transportation for grants to local governments for traffic signal retiming projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Mesquite authorizes the submission of applications to the Texas Department of Transportation for Traffic Light Synchronization grants and, if the applications are selected for funding, James A. Prugel, Jr., City Manager, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City of Mesquite all necessary applications, contracts, and agreements to implement and carry out the purposes specified.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage as the law in such cases provides.
