

RESOLUTION NO. 16-94

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS ON MAY 7, 1994, FOR THE ELECTION OF CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR PLACES 3, 4, AND 5; CALLING A RUNOFF ELECTION TO BE HELD JUNE 4, 1994; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, an election was held on May 7, 1994, in the City of Mesquite, Texas, for the purpose of electing Councilmembers for each of the following places: Nos. 3, 4, and 5; for two (2) year terms; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, election officials for that election have made their returns to the City Council in the time and manner provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That, the City Council, having canvassed said returns, has determined that the total number of votes cast in the election held May 7, 1994, was 2,847 and the results of said election are hereby declared to be as follows:

It appearing that Steve Alexander received a majority of votes cast for the Office of Councilmember, Place 3, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying for a term of two (2) years, commencing May, 1994, and until a successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.

It appearing that no candidate received a majority of votes cast for the Office of Councilmember, Place 4, it is necessary to call a run-off election to be held June 4, 1994, for the purpose of deciding between Mark S. Mims and Vernie G. Erwin for the Office of Councilmember, Place 4.

It appearing that James W. Folks received a majority of votes cast for the Office of Councilmember, Place 5, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying for a term of two (2) years, commencing May, 1994, and until a successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.

SECTION 2. Early voting by personal appearance for the June 4, 1994, Runoff Election shall be conducted by the Dallas County Elections Administrator, who is hereby appointed clerk of early voting in compliance with Section 271.006 of the Texas Election Code. Early voting will be conducted at Dunford Community Center, 1015 Green Canyon, Mesquite, Texas. Any qualified voter for the Runoff Election may vote early by personal appearance at Dunford Community Center.

Early voting by personal appearance will be conducted on weekdays beginning Monday, May 16, 1994, and continuing through Friday, May 27, 1994, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Saturday, May 21, 1994, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., and Tuesday, May 31, 1994, between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.



SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage as the Charter in such cases provides.



