

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF A RUNOFF ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS ON JUNE 4, 1994, FOR THE ELECTION OF A CITY COUNCILMEMBER FOR PLACE 4; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, a Runoff Election was held on June 4, 1994, in the City of Mesquite, Texas, for the purpose of electing a Councilmember for Place 4 for a two (2) year term; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, election officials for that election have made their returns to the City Council in the time and manner provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That, the City Council, having canvassed said returns, has determined that the total number of votes cast in the election held June 4, 1994, was 1,280 and the results of said election are hereby declared to be as follows:

Vernie G. Ervin	<u>536</u>


