## RESOLUTION NO. 35-94

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENTS TO THE RECIPROCAL AGREEMENT FOR EMERGENCY SUPPLY OF TREATED WATER BETWEEN THE CITY OF MESQUITE AND THE CITY OF DALLAS AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, on September 19, 1984 the City of Mesquite and the City of Dallas entered into an agreement providing for an emergency reciprocal supply of treated water; and

WHEREAS, it is beneficial to both cities to extend the terms of this agreement by supplemental agreement(s) to the original agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That James A. Prugel, Jr., City Manager, is hereby authorized to act on behalf of the City of Mesquite and sign Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to Emergency Reciprocal Agreement extending the terms of the Agreement to the year 2004, and such authorization of the City Manager shall be inclusive of future Supplemental Agreements thereto.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage as the Charter in such cases provides.
