A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENTS TO THE WATER/WASTEWATER RECIPROCAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MESQUITE AND THE CITY OF DALLAS AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, on June 10, 1974 the City of Mesquite and the City of Dallas entered into an agreement whereby each city would provide water and sanitary sewer service to citizens of the other city from water and/or sanitary sewer mains located along streets, roadways, alleys and easements constituting common boundaries of the cities; and

WHEREAS, it is beneficial to both cities to extend the terms of this agreement by supplemental agreement(s) to the original agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That James A. Prugel, Jr., City Manager, is hereby authorized to act on behalf of the City of Mesquite and sign Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to Water/Wastewater Reciprocal Services Agreement extending the terms of the Agreement to the year 2004, and such authorization of the City Manager shall be inclusive of future Supplemental Agreements thereto.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage as the Charter in such cases provides.
