**CITY OF MESQUITE  
NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE OF COMBINATION TAX AND REVENUE  
CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION, SERIES 1994**

The City of Mesquite does hereby give notice of intention to issue Combination Tax and Revenue Certificates of Obligation, Series 1994, in the maximum principal amount not to exceed \$6,440,000 for paying all or a portion of the City's contractual obligations for the purpose of acquiring lands for drainage, municipal service center, Interstate 20 land for future municipal building; acquiring, constructing, improving and equipping a municipal health clinic building, municipal landfill, convention center, municipal warehouse expansion, Teex municipal building, fire station, civic center, municipal airport (runways and instrument landing system), demolition of Brentwood Apartments; and the study, purchase and installation of hardware equipment for the Police Computer Aided Dispatch System, purchase and installation of Municipal Early Warning System, and study, purchase and installation of hardware for Municipal Records Management System, and for paying legal, fiscal, architectural, engineering and professional fees in connection with such projects. The City proposes to provide for the payment of such Certificates of Obligation from the levy and collection of ad valorem taxes in the City as provided by law, and from a limited pledge of the surplus revenues of the City's Waterworks and Sewer System, remaining after payment of all operation and maintenance expenses thereof, and all debt service, reserve, and other requirements in connection with any of the City's revenue bonds or other obligations (now or hereafter outstanding), which are payable from all or any part of the Net Revenues of the City's Waterworks and Sewer System. The City Council intends to consider for passage, at a Regular Meeting to be held at 3:00 P.M. on December 5, 1994, an Ordinance authorizing the issuance of Combination Tax and Revenue Certificates of Obligation, Series 1994, at the City Hall, 711 N. Galloway, Mesquite, Texas.
