

RESOLUTION NO. 18-95

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ON MAY 6, 1995, FOR THE ELECTION OF A MAYOR AND CITY COUNCILMEMBERS FOR PLACES 1, 2, AND 6; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, an election was held on May 6, 1995, in the City of Mesquite, Texas, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and Councilmembers for each of the following places: Nos. 1, 2, and 6; for two (2) year terms; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, election officials for that election have made their returns to the City Council in the time and manner provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That, the City Council, having canvassed said returns, has determined that the total number of votes cast in the election held May 6, 1995, was 3,283 and the results of said election are hereby declared to be as follows:


