WHEREAS, In Civil Action No. B-91-166; Texas Municipal League Group Benefits Risk Pool and the City of Pasadena v. Hartford Life and Accident Company, the City of Mesquite was a party Plaintiff; and

WHEREAS, A settlement agreement was made in behalf of the City of Mesquite as follows:

That the City of Mesquite accepts \$630,466.20 as full payment for Mesquite's claim against The Hartford Insurance Company and the payment of the attorney's fees and expenses as set out above, are hereby approved.
