

RESOLUTION NO. 18-96

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, DESIGNATING A RESPONSIBLE OFFICER AND A FISCAL OFFICER TO SERVE THE CITY OF MESQUITE FOR REQUESTING A LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT BLOCK GRANT FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite is endeavoring to establish a Citizens Police Academy, to upgrade public safety communications systems, and to acquire a police investigations vehicle; and


WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite is requesting funding for such programs from the Bureau of Justice Assistance in the aggregate amount of \$136,900 and anticipates authorizing the expenditure of \$15,211 as the City's cash match;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Ted Barron, City Manager, is hereby designated Responsible Officer and Don Simons, Director of Finance is hereby designated Fiscal Officer for the purpose of requesting, receiving, and disbursing funds through the Bureau of Justice Assistance for this purpose.


SECTION 2. That the Resolution shall take effect immediately upon date of passage as the law in such cases provides.
