

RESOLUTION NO. 20-96

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, DESIGNATING A RESPONSIBLE OFFICER TO SERVE THE CITY OF MESQUITE IN IMPLEMENTING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS CRIMINAL JUSTICE POLICY COUNCIL FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE STATE'S LIVE SCAN FINGERPRINT AND ELECTRONIC ARREST REPORTING SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice has made available to the states federal National Criminal History Improvement Program (NCHIP) grant funds to improve the quality of criminal history records across the nation; and

WHEREAS, Governor George Bush designated the Criminal Justice Policy Council to develop and submit a grant application on behalf of the State of Texas, and the Criminal Justice Policy Council received an award under the above program; and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice Policy Council will use these grant funds to implement a model paperless arrest reporting system to capture information on offenders and offenses and transmit that information to the state Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS) electronically over telecommunications lines along with the digitized fingerprint images created by the Live Scan workstation; and

WHEREAS, this program will reduce the paper generating, processing, and mailing tasks currently placed on city arrest booking personnel; and

WHEREAS, these grant funds are intended to cover 100% of all reasonable local costs for participation in this project and do not require any local or in-kind match;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


**SECTION 1.** That Ted Barron, City Manager, is hereby designated Responsible Officer for the purpose of entering into an agreement with the State of Texas under which the Texas Criminal Justice Policy Council will provide an electronic Live Scan Fingerprint Workstation for the City of Mesquite.

**SECTION 2.** That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon date of passage as the law in such cases provides.




