

RESOLUTION NO. 21-96

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE 1996-97 CONTRACT WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS SOUTHWESTERN MEDICAL CENTER AT DALLAS, PROVIDING THAT FUTURE AUTHORIZATIONS SHALL BE THROUGH PLACEMENT OF THE ITEMS ON THE CITY COUNCIL CONSENT AGENDA, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite through its Fire Department provides Emergency Medical Services (EMS); and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite has been under the direction of The University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas since 1983 and has received continuing education, the services of a medical director and related services; and

WHEREAS, the amount of this contract is determined each year and it is anticipated that this contractual relationship will continue for many years; and

WHEREAS, it is determined that the approval of such Contract may be more efficiently accomplished through the placement of the item on the City Council consent agenda, rather than through the Resolution process;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager, is hereby authorized to act on behalf of the City of Mesquite and execute the 1996-97 contract with The University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas whereby The University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas provides a Medical Director for the City's EMS program and continuing education and related services to EMS personnel.






