## RESOLUTION NO. 02-97

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, DESIGNATING A RESPONSIBLE OFFICER AND A FISCAL OFFICER TO SERVE THE CITY OF MESQUITE FOR REQUESTING A GRANT FROM THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION OF THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite is endeavoring to continue a School Resource Officer Program for four selected Middle Schools within the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite is requesting funding for such a program from the Criminal Justice Division of the Office of the Governor in the amount of \$160,153 and anticipates authorizing the expenditure of approximately \$35,369 as the City's match in cash contribution and anticipates receiving approximately \$35,369 as the Mesquite Independent School District's match in cash contribution; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the City of Mesquite will endorse this project based on availability of funds and the success of the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Ted Barron, City Manager, is hereby authorized to apply for a grant through the Criminal Justice Division of the Office of the Governor for this purpose.

SECTION 2. That Ted Barron, City Manager, is hereby designated Responsible Officer and Don Simons, Director of Finance, is hereby designated Piscal Officer for the purpose of requesting, receiving and disbursing funds through the Criminal Justice Division of the Office of the Governor for this purpose.

SECTION 3. That in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the Criminal Justice Division of the Office of the Governor is assured that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon date of passage as the law in such cases provides.
