

RESOLUTION NO. 08-97

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING PRECINCTS AND THE LOCATIONS OF POLLING PLACES FOR THE ANNUAL CITY ELECTION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, has called the annual general election to be held May 3, 1997, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and Councilmembers for Places 1, 2 and 6.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS;

SECTION 1. That the City election precincts for this election shall consist of the territory located within the corporate limits of the City bearing the following numbers, and the polling places at said election shall be as follows, to wit:



SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage as the Charter in such cases provides.


