

RESOLUTION NO. 10-97

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, IN SUPPORT OF THE POLICY POSITION ON STATE LEGISLATIVE ISSUES FOR THE 75TH SESSION OF THE TEXAS LEGISLATURE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the 75th Texas Legislature will be in session from January to June of 1997; and

WHEREAS, Texas' transportation system and related improvements will be a critical issue to be considered and debated by the 75th Legislature during the session; and

WHEREAS, the Dallas-Fort Worth Area Partners In Mobility is a coalition of elected officials and business and civic leaders from the North Central Texas region who are committed to maintaining the viability of the Dallas-Fort Worth regional economy by improving the area's surface transportation system through continued investment; and

WHEREAS, the Dallas-Fort Worth Area Partners In Mobility have worked in successful partnership with the Texas Transportation Commission since 1995; and

WHEREAS, the region's ability to fund the transportation improvements identified in Mobility 2020: The Metropolitan Transportation Plan will be significantly impacted by the work of the Texas Legislature; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the Dallas-Fort Worth region for the City of Mesquite to take a position on state legislative issues for the 75th Legislative Session;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


**SECTION 1.** That the City of Mesquite is in support of the attached Partners In Mobility Position on State Legislative Issues for the 75th Texas Legislative Session.


