A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MESQUITE, TEXAS, APPROVING THE REVISED PARKS
AND RECREATION COMPREHENSIVE PARKS MASTER
PLAN FOR 1997 THROUGH THE YEAR 2001.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite, recognizes the need to insure proper and orderly growth of its Parks and Recreation facilities, programs and activities; and

WHEREAS, Parks and Recreation Planning is recognized to be of primary importance for the further growth and development of the City of Mesquite's Parks and Recreation Department and the programs it is charged to conduct; and


WHEREAS, the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department can arrange for the financial assistance from a special tax;

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon date of passage, as the Charter in such cases provides.


