

RESOLUTION NO. 27-97

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, COMMITTING TO ACHIEVING A REDUCTION IN SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AND AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP TO THE TEXAS NATURAL RESOURCE CONSERVATION COMMISSION'S CLEAN CITIES 2000 PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Texas Legislature has established a forty percent waste reduction goal for Texas cities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite desires to continue its development of a comprehensive solid waste reduction program which serves both the City and the community; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission's Clean Cities 2000 program recognizes communities that voluntarily develop comprehensive environmental programs through a City Plan of Action; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of the City of Mesquite to apply for membership to the Clean Cities 2000 program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite commits to achieving a reduction in solid waste disposal by the year 2000 through the implementation of a comprehensive City Plan of Action of solid waste reduction.


