

RESOLUTION NO. 32-97

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, FINDING THAT THE JUVENILE CURFEW ORDINANCE HAS HAD A POSITIVE EFFECT ON THE COMMUNITY AND ON THE PROBLEMS THE ORDINANCE WAS INTENDED TO REMEDY, AND CONTINUING THE ORDINANCE FOR THE PERIOD AUTHORIZED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, enacted Ordinance Number 2996 on October 3, 1994, establishing a curfew applicable to persons under 17 years of age; and

WHEREAS, Texas state law codified as Chapter 370.002, Texas Local Government Code, requires the governing body of a home-rule municipality to review the effects of the ordinance on the community and on the problems the ordinance was intended to remedy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed those effects and conducted a public hearing on the need to continue the ordinance, and


WHEREAS, the City Council has found that there is a need to continue the ordinance in effect;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That Ordinance 2996, enacted October 3, 1994, be continued in effect for the duration established by law.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon date of passage as the law in such cases provides.
