

RESOLUTION NO. 36-97

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
MESQUITE, TEXAS, ALLOCATING FUNDING RECEIVED  
THROUGH THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT BLOCK  
GRANTS PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite, Texas, anticipates receipt of funds under the Local Law Enforcement Block Grants Program of the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has received and considered the input of a local Advisory Board, consisting of representatives of the local law enforcement agency, the local prosecutor's office, the local court system, the local public school system, and a local nonprofit group active in crime prevention and drug use prevention; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has conducted a public hearing on the proposed allocation of grant funds; and


WHEREAS, the City Council has concurred with the allocation of funds to projects listed on the attached schedule;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That funds received by the City of Mesquite under the Local Law Enforcement Block Grants Program, together with the required local cash match, be allocated to the projects listed on the attached schedule.


SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon date of passage as the law in such cases provides.


