

RESOLUTION NO. 42-97

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING PRECINCTS AND THE LOCATIONS OF POLLING PLACES FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON JANUARY 17, 1998, TO DETERMINE WHETHER TO ADOPT AN ADDITIONAL ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT SALES AND USE TAX TO BE USED FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, has called a special election to be held January 17, 1998, for the purpose of determining whether to adopt an additional one-half of one percent sales and use tax to be used for economic development:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS;

SECTION 1. That the City election precincts for this election shall consist of the territory located within the corporate limits of the City bearing the following numbers, and the polling places at said election shall be as follows, to wit:



Florence Park Community Center 2501 Whitson Way	2247, 2249, 2259, 2300, 2301 and 2308
Scott Dunford Community Center 1015 Green Canyon	2142, 2302, 2304, 2305, 2306, 2313 and 2314

None but legally qualified voters of the City of Mesquite shall be entitled to vote at said election.


