

RESOLUTION NO. 43-97

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, APPOINTING A REPRESENTATIVE TO SERVE ON THE EARLY VOTING BALLOT BOARD FOR THE JANUARY 17, 1998, SPECIAL ELECTION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, has called a special election to be held January 17, 1998, for the purpose of determining whether to adopt an additional one-half of one percent sales and use tax to be used for economic development; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite has entered into a Joint Election Agreement/Election Services Contract with Dallas County; and


WHEREAS, the provisions of the Joint Election Agreement/Election Services Contract call for each entity to appoint a representative to the Early Voting Ballot Board for said election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That under the provisions of the Joint Election Agreement/Election Services Contract with Dallas County, Betty Jean Turner, 3901 Emerald Drive, Mesquite, Texas, is hereby appointed as the City of Mesquite's representative on the Early Voting Ballot Board for the Special Election to be held January 17, 1998.


SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon date of passage as the Charter in such cases provides.
