A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, DESIGNATING A RESPONSIBLE OFFICER AND A FISCAL OFFICER TO SERVE THE CITY OF MESQUITE FOR REQUESTING A GRANT FROM THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION OF THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Mesquite, that the School Resource Officer Program for four selected Middle Schools be operated by the Police Department for the 3rd year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite is requesting funding for such a program under the Criminal Justice Planning (421) Fund Program from the Criminal Justice Division of the Office of the Governor in the amount of \$120,116 and anticipates authorizing the expenditure of approximately \$39,253 as the City's match in cash contribution and anticipates receiving approximately \$39,253 as the Mesquite Independent School District's match in cash contribution; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the City of Mesquite will endorse this project based on availability of funds and the success of the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Ted Barron, City Manager, is hereby authorized to apply for a grant through the Criminal Justice Division of the Office of the Governor for this purpose.

SECTION 2. That Ted Barron, City Manager, is hereby designated Responsible Officer and Don Siinons, Director of Finance, is hereby designated Fiscal Officer for the purpose of requesting, receiving and disbursing funds through the Criminal Justice Division of the Office of the Governor for this purpose.

SECTION 3. That in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the Criminal Justice Division of the Office of the Governor is assured that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full

<u>SECTION 4.</u> That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon date of passage as the law in such cases provides.
