

RESOLUTION NO. 02-98

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, SUPPORTING AN ADDITIONAL FIVE THOUSAND (\$5,000.00) DOLLAR EXEMPTION ON AD VALOREM TAXATION ON THE RESIDENTIAL HOMESTEAD OF INDIVIDUALS, WHO ARE SIXTY-FIVE (65) YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER, PROVIDED THAT THE 4(B) SALES TAX ISSUE IS APPROVED BY THE CITY OF MESQUITE VOTERS ON JANUARY 17, 1998; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.


WHEREAS, on February 3, 1992, the City Council of the City of Mesquite passed Ordinance No. 2794 providing for a Forty-Five Thousand (\$45,000.00) Dollar ad valorem tax exemption to qualified individuals sixty-five (65) years of age or older;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the City Council hereby expresses support of an additional exemption from ad valorem taxation in the amount of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars on the residence homestead of individuals who are sixty-five (65) years of age or older, provided that the 4(B) sales tax issue is approved by the City of Mesquite voters on January 17, 1998.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall become effective beginning with the ad valorem tax year of 1998.
