

RESOLUTION NO. 03-98

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, SUPPORTING A DECREASE OF FIFTY CENTS (\$.50) IN THE MONTHLY CHARGE FOR SANITATION SERVICE FOR PERSONS WHO ARE SIXTY-FIVE (65) YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER, PROVIDED THAT THE 4(B) SALES TAX ISSUE IS APPROVED BY THE CITY OF MESQUITE VOTERS ON JANUARY 17, 1998; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.


WHEREAS, on September 15, 1997, the City Council of the City of Mesquite passed Ordinance No. 3177 increasing the charge for a one-family residence to Nine Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$9.50) for monthly collection for sanitation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the City Council hereby expresses support of a decrease of Fifty Cents (\$.50) in the monthly charge for sanitation service for persons who are sixty-five (65) years of age or older provided that the 4(B) sales tax issue is approved by the City of Mesquite voters on January 17, 1998.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall become effective February 1, 1998.
