

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, SUPPORTING A REDUCTION IN THE DEPOSIT FOR NEW WATER ACCOUNTS FROM FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) TO TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) FOR PERSONS WHO ARE SIXTY-FIVE (65) YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER, PROVIDED THAT THE 4(B) SALES TAX ISSUE IS APPROVED BY THE CITY OF MESQUITE VOTERS ON JANUARY 17, 1998; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, on September 20, 1993, the City Council of the City of Mesquite passed Ordinance No. 2901 establishing Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) as the amount of residential deposit when making application for water service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council hereby expresses support of a reduction in the deposit for new water accounts from Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) to Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for persons who are sixty-five (65) years of age or older provided that the 4(B) sales tax issue is approved by the City of Mesquite voters on January 17, 1998.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall become effective February 1, 1998.
