

RESOLUTION NO. 10-98

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, APPOINTING A REPRESENTATIVE TO SERVE ON THE EARLY VOTING BALLOT BOARD FOR THE MAY 2, 1998, JOINT ELECTION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, has called the annual general election to be held May 2, 1998, for the purpose of electing Councilmembers for Places 3, 4 and 5.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite has entered into a Joint Election Agreement/Election Services Contract with Dallas County; and


WHEREAS, the provisions of the Joint Election Agreement/Election Services Contract call for each entity to appoint a representative to the Early Voting Ballot Board for said election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:



That under the provisions of the Joint Election Agreement/Election Services Contract with Dallas County, Betty Jean Turner, 3901 Emerald Drive, Mesquite, Texas, is hereby appointed as the City of Mesquite's representative on the Early Voting Ballot Board for the Joint Election to be held May 2, 1998.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon date of passage, as the Charter in such cases provides.
