

RESOLUTION NO. 14-98

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS ON MAY 2, 1998, FOR THE ELECTION OF CITY COUNCILMEMBERS FOR PLACES 3, 4, AND 5; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, an election was held on May 2, 1998, in the City of Mesquite, Texas, for the purpose of electing Councilmembers for each of the following places: Nos. 3, 4, and 5; for two (2) year terms; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, election officials for that election have made their returns to the City Council in the time and manner provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That, the City Council, having canvassed said returns, has determined that the total number of votes cast in the election held May 2, 1998, was 2237 and the results of said election are hereby declared to be as follows:


SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage as the Charter in such cases provides.


