

RESOLUTION NO. 19-98

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, DESIGNATING A RESPONSIBLE OFFICER AND A FISCAL OFFICER TO SERVE THE CITY OF MESQUITE FOR REQUESTING A GRANT FROM THE OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES OF THE U. S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite is endeavoring to acquire and establish a COPS MORE Community Policing Program within the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite is requesting funding for such a program from the Office of Community Oriented Policing Services of the U. S. Department of Justice in the amount of \$35,950 and anticipates authorizing the expenditure of approximately \$14,643 as the City's match in cash contribution over a one year period; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the City of Mesquite will endorse this project based on availability of funds and the success of the project;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Ted Barron, City Manager, is hereby authorized to apply for a grant through the Office of Community Oriented Policing Services of the U.S. Department of Justice for this purpose.


SECTION 2. That Ted Barron, City Manager, is hereby designated Responsible Officer and Don Simons, Director of Finance, is hereby designated Fiscal Officer for the purpose of requesting, receiving and disbursing funds through the Office of Community Oriented Policing Services of the U. S. Department Justice for this purpose.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon date of passage as the law such cases provides.
