

RESOLUTION NO. 27-99

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING \$1,167,829 FOR FEDERAL FUNDS UNDER THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACT AND DESIGNATING THE CITY MANAGER AS CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE PURPOSE OF GIVING REQUIRED ASSURANCES AN ACTING IN CONNECTION WITH SAID APPLICATION AND DECLARING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite is entitled to certain funds under the Housing and Community Development Act in an amount not to exceed \$1,167,829 (See Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance) in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funds for the year 1999-2000 program year; and

WHEREAS, the City has conducted public hearings; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the suggestions and recommendations raised at the hearings; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest of the citizens of the City of Mesquite that application be made for such funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Fiscal Year 2000 CDBG expenditures in Exhibit "A" are hereby approved and adopted by the City of Mesquite as its 1999-2000 Community Development Block Grant Program.

SECTION 2. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite authorizes Ted Barron, City Manager of the City of Mesquite, to file an application for funds under the Housing and Community Development Act on behalf of the City of Mesquite, Texas, and to certify all understandings and assurances required under Federal Management Circular 74-4; National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, Titles VI and VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and 1968 respectively, Executive Orders 11063 and 11246 and such other assurances as may be required.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
