

RESOLUTION NO. 33-99

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, NOMINATING DR. RALPH HARRIS POTEET AS A CANDIDATE FOR RE-ELECTION AS THE SUBURBAN CITIES' REPRESENTATIVE TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DALLAS CENTRAL APPRAISAL DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Chief Appraiser of the Dallas Central Appraisal District has been charged with the responsibility of conducting the election process to determine the membership of the Board of Directors of the Dallas Central Appraisal District, according to the Property Tax Code of Texas; and

WHEREAS, each of the eligible incorporated cities and towns, except for the City of Dallas, shall have the right to nominate by an official resolution one (1) candidate to be a member of the Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, said cities and towns shall, from among the nominations received, elect by a majority vote, with each city and town being entitled to one (1) vote, a member of the Board of Directors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite does hereby nominate Dr. Ralph Harris Poteet as a candidate for re-election as the suburban cities' representative to the Board of Directors of the Dallas Central Appraisal District.
