

RESOLUTION NO. 44-2000

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, DESIGNATING A RESPONSIBLE OFFICER AND A FISCAL OFFICER TO SERVE THE CITY OF MESQUITE FOR ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite is endeavoring to utilize commissioned police personnel in the most effective manner possible; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite is requesting funding for additional civilian personnel to perform services currently performed by commissioned police officers, thereby returning commissioned police officers to more appropriate duties; and

WHEREAS, such funding for this program may be available from the United States Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services, in the amount of \$74,509; and


WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite anticipates authorizing the expenditure of \$24,836 as the City's required cash match.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Ted Barron, City Manager, is hereby designated Responsible Officer and Don Simons, Director of Finance, is hereby designated Fiscal Officer for the purpose of requesting, receiving and disbursing funds through the Department of Justice for this purpose.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its passage.
