

RESOLUTION NO. 04-2001

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STATE RIGHT-OF-WAY ON MARCH 31, 2001, FOR THE MESQUITE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE RODEO PARADE.

WHEREAS, the Mesquite Chamber of Commerce is planning its 44th annual rodeo parade for downtown Mesquite on March 31, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite desires to encourage the economic vitality of downtown Mesquite and recognizes the value of the rodeo parade and festival in achieving this goal; and

WHEREAS, Main Street and Davis Street are the eastbound and westbound legs of State Highway 352 through downtown Mesquite; and


WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation will allow the temporary closure of Main Street and Davis Street for the rodeo parade and festival upon execution of an agreement for the temporary closure of State right-of-way between the Texas Department of Transportation and the City of Mesquite.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite authorizes Ted Barron, City Manager of the City of Mesquite, to execute an agreement for the temporary closure of State right-of-way between the Texas Department of Transportation and the City of Mesquite for temporary closure of Main Street and Davis Street between Belt Line Road and Ebrite Street on March 31, 2001, for the rodeo parade and festival.


SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its passage.


