

RESOLUTION NO. 22-2001

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STATE RIGHT-OF-WAY ON JUNE 9, 2001, FOR THE TEXAS SHRINE ASSOCIATION CONVENTION PARADE.

WHEREAS, the Texas Shrine Association is holding its annual convention in Mesquite and is planning a parade through downtown Mesquite on June 9, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Shrine Association operates a network of charitable hospitals offering treatment to children who are burn victims at no cost; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite desires to encourage the Shriners in their charitable work and recognizes the value of the parade in achieving this goal by increasing community awareness; and

WHEREAS, Main Street and Davis Street are the eastbound and westbound legs of State Highway 352 through downtown Mesquite; and


WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation will allow the temporary closure of Main Street and Davis Street for the Texas Shrine Association Convention Parade upon execution of an agreement for the temporary closure of State right-of-way between the Texas Department of Transportation and the City of Mesquite.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite authorizes Ted Barron, City Manager of the City of Mesquite, to execute an agreement for the temporary closure of State right-of-way between the Texas Department of Transportation and the City of Mesquite for temporary closure of Main Street and Davis Street between Lindo Drive and Walker Street on June 9, 2001, for the Texas Shrine Association Convention Parade.


SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its passage.


