RESOLUTION NO. 26-2001

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE OFFICE OF NATIONAL DRUG CONTROL POLICY AND OFFICE OF JUVENILE JUSTICE AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, FOR A GRANT UNDER THE DRUG FREE COMMUNITIES SUPPORT PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF A MATCHING SHARE NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000.00).

WHEREAS, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the applicant including the provision by it of the local share of project costs through in kind resources, funds, donations and volunteer support; and

WHEREAS, it is required by the Office of National Drug Policy and the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, that in connection with the filing of an application under the Drug Free Communities Support Program, the applicant gives an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Office of National Drug Policy and the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention requirements thereunder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF MESQUITE OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

- SECTION 1. That Ted Barron, City Manager, is authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the City of Mesquite with the Office of National Drug Control Policy and the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention to aid in the financing of projects pursuant to the Drug Free Communities Support Program.
- SECTION 2. That Ted Barron, City Manager, is authorized to execute and file with such applications an assurance or any other document required by the Office of National Drug Control Policy or the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention effectuating the purpose of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
- SECTION 3. That Ted Barron, City Manager, is authorized to furnish such additional information as the Office of National Drug Policy or the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention may require in connection with the application for the project.
- SECTION 4. That Ted Barron, City Manager, is authorized to execute grant contract agreements on behalf of City of Mesquite with the Office of National Drug Control Policy and the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention to aid in the financing of the projects included in the Drug Free Communities Support Program.
- SECTION 5. That the City of Mesquite hereby certifies that the matching share for this application is readily available at this time not to exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) and hereby authorizes such expenditure through in kind resources, funds, donations and volunteer support.
